

# **GREATER ERRINGTON ZUCCHINI RACE**

Errington Farmers Market

## **RULES**

- 1. Pairs of zucchini race cars will be released from a launching ramp and distance traveled from the bottom of the ramp to the tip of the zucchini will be measured.**
- 2. The two cars that travel the greatest distance will have a run-off to decide the winner. (i.e., the winner must be sturdy enough to survive 2 runs down the ramp.)**
- 3. Any size zucchini can enter but the maximum allowable wheel width from outside to outside of the widest wheels must be no more than 28 cm and the wheel diameter must be 14 cm or less.**
- 4. No kind of engine or mechanical drive system, including rubber bands, will be allowed.**
- 5. The axle shaft must penetrate the body of the zucchini; no external carriage or cradle is allowed.**
- 6. Assembly time will be 10:30 am on the field.**
- 7. No plumping is allowed; winners will be tested for weight-enhancing stuffing.**
- 8. Zucchini entries must be grown in the greater Errington area: i.e. from the Comox Valley in the north to the Malahat in the south; Alberni Valley in the west to Georgia straight in the east.**
- 9. In case of fatal accidents, competitors must remove the remains.**

**Two races will be run: 13 and under (Kids) & 14 and over.**

**Prizes will be awarded for greatest distance and best decorated.**
